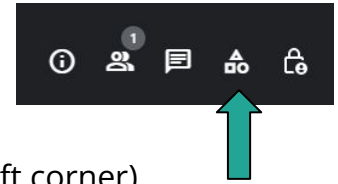
Primary risk factor for CDI	Antibiotic exposure, particularly 3rd generation cephalosporins, clindamycin, and fluoroquinolones
C. difficile colonization	1-3% of the population is colonized with C. diff. Colonization may actually be protective against CDI, especially if colonized with non-toxin producing strains. Treatment not recommended for asymptomatic colonization.
C. difficile infection (CDI) symptoms	Diarrhea is always present. Abdominal pain/cramping, fever, and elevated WBC may also occur.
Group with highest C. diff mortality risk	Elderly adults

# Google Meet



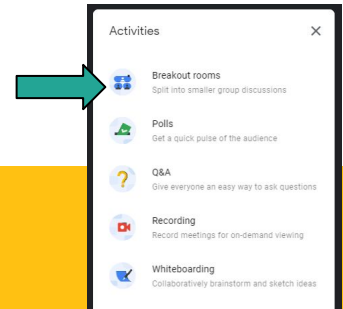
- Breakout rooms

**Instructions:**

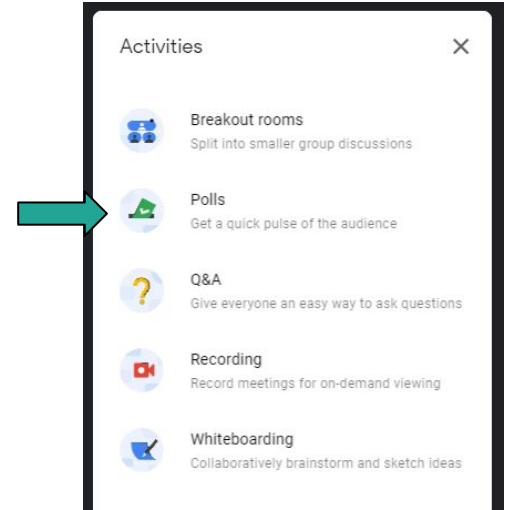
1. Start a video call in Google Meet
2. Click the “Activities” icon (the icon of the circle, square, and triangle in the lower left corner)
3. Click “Breakout rooms”
4. Click the “Edit” pencil icon and choose the number of breakout rooms you want to create
  - a. Participants can then be distributed across rooms
5. Move participants to different rooms by either entering someone’s name into the room or clicking and dragging it there
  - a. The shuffle button mixes groups at random
6. Click “Open Rooms” in the bottom right to activate the rooms
7. You can also set a timer for breakout rooms by visiting the top of the breakout rooms panel and clicking the hourglass icon
  - a. You can change or remove the timer at any point
8. End all breakout rooms by selecting “Close rooms” in the top right of the breakout room panel.
  - a. Click “Close all rooms” in the pop-up window to bring participants back to the main room



# Breakout Rooms

## Advantages of using Polls:

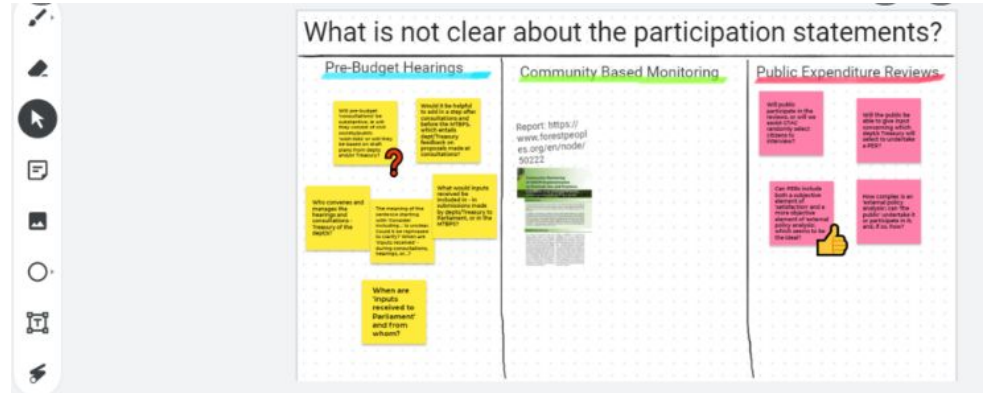
- Create and save poll questions
- Launch poll questions anytime during the presentation
- Showcase the responses
- Use a poll before or after information has been discussed

## Whiteboard:

- Collaboratively brainstorm and sketch ideas as a group
- Automatically adds a link to the chat for everyone to join
- Once participants click the link, collaboration can begin
- Tools that can be utilized within Whiteboard are:
  - Textbox
  - Shapes
  - Sticky notes
  - Upload an image Laser

Web-based tools for creating presentations (prezis for short) that offers unique features

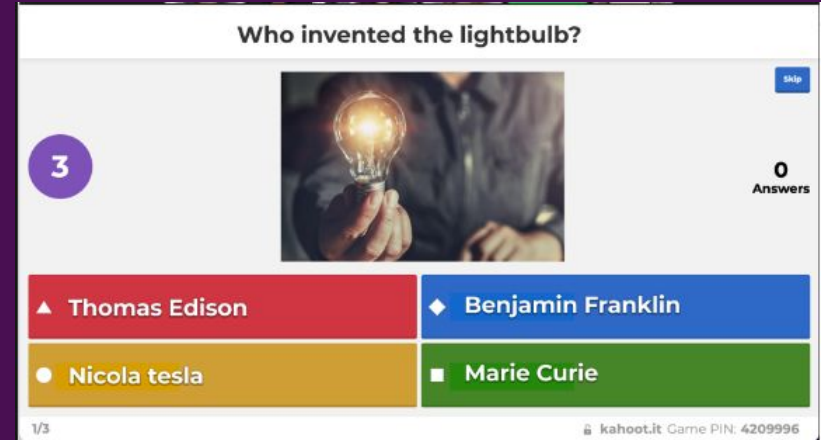
